GFD's response area is approximately 64.5 square miles, and the Department maintains an ISO classification of 2. In addition to fire suppression and emergency medical response, the department is responsible for fire inspections and code enforcement, public education and prevention programs, and fire investigations. Other specialized services include hazardous materials, dive rescue, wildland, and technical rescue response

Greeley Fire is seeking a Division Chief of Operations who is a skilled supervisor and proven leader. The ideal candidate will have a proven successful background in fire service operations with increasingly responsible supervisory and managerial experience in a command capacity. Strong communication and emotional intelligence, the ability to manage change in times of uncertainty, and a willingness to set clear expectations to create a culture of accountability will serve the Division Chief well.

The position requires a bachelor's degree with major course work in the area of Fire Science, Fire Administration, Public Administration, Business Administration, or other closely related field AND a minimum of eight (8) years of documented successful fire and emergency services experience AND at least three (3) years of management and administrative responsibility at the level of Battalion Chief, or a position equivalent to that of a Battalion Chief in a similar sized department.
