### **QUALIFICATIONS**

- 18 years old or older and have a high school diploma or the equivalent.
- For Firefighter: EMT license or National Registry certification as an EMT at time of application. Must possess State of Oregon EMT license by date of employment as a firefighter.
- For Firefighter Paramedic: Paramedic license or National Registry certification as a paramedic at time of application. Must possess State of Oregon Paramedic license by date of employment as a firefighter paramedic
- Passing score on the FireTEAM test.
- Candidates must have completed and passed the Candidate Physical Abilities Test (CPAT) within the date range of December 2, 2021, to January 31, 2023. A CPAT will be accepted from any organization authorized and licensed by the IAFF and IAFC.
- Current valid driver's license and a driving record insurable by the District's insurer.

#### **COMPENSATION & BENEFITS TVF&R OFFERS**

The monthly salary range within a step system for this position is \$5,493.13 - \$7,817.82 per month. Per the collective bargaining agreement, the starting pay will be \$5,493.13 per month.
